**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Amendment No. 2 to the WRA Operating Contract to address financial services from the operating contractor

**SYNOPSIS:**

Approval of Amendment No. 2 to the Operating Contract between the WRA and the City of Des Moines which strikes the words “through the City of Des Moines Financial Department.” and removes that limitation.

**FISCAL IMPACT: NONE**

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

City of Des Moines’ staff operates the Wastewater Reclamation Facility under Amendment No. 1 of the WRA Operating Contract. Financial Services provided pursuant to the Operating Agreement are not solely provided through the “City of Des Moines Finance Department” as stated in Division 5, Section 2.31. City of Des Moines Public Works Department also provides Financial Services.

The Senior Budget Analyst obtains assistance and guidance from the City of Des Moines Finance Director while reporting to the City of Des Moines Public Works Director. It was determined by the Operating Contractor that the position needed to be an advocate for the WRA so this reporting change was made.

This Amendment to the Operating Contract strikes the words “through the City of Des Moines Finance Department” and will remove that limitation, meaning that any City of Des Moines Department could provide Financial Services to the WRA.
