

SYNOPSIS —

The Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse has invited the Des Moines Police Department to submit an application for reversionary funding to allow for the purchase of a photocopier in lieu of leasing this piece of equipment. The photocopier is for use in our Crime-Free Multi-Housing Program.

FISCAL IMPACT —

Our proposal calls for the purchase of a photocopier instead of leasing the equipment. The estimated cost of this copier is \$8,000. The Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse would provide \$6,000 of this total with the City match being \$2,000. The Police Department has identified funds from forfeited assets as the match.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval.

BACKGROUND —

The Des Moines Police Department applied for and received funding from the Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse (GASA) for a Crime-Free Multi-Housing Program. In the original grant application, we proposed leasing a photocopier. GASA has additional reversionary funds available and has invited the Police Department to submit a letter of proposal to purchase the photocopier instead of leasing it.
