

SYNOPSIS —

Compensation to Des Moines Water Works in the amount of \$95,558.30 is for the relocation of a park road which is located in portions of the new Corps of Engineers levee.

FISCAL IMPACT —

Funds for this payment are available from the Valley Drive, Bell Avenue, Raccoon River Flood Protection, page 95, 1995-96 CIP, Index Code 332940 (with \$95,558.30 transfer from Index 760827 - FEMA Non-Reimbursable Costs 1993).

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval.

BACKGROUND —

The City of Des Moines has been working with the Corps of Engineers for the construction of a 100-year flood protection known as Valley Drive, Bell Avenue, Raccoon River Flood Protection.

There are approximately 600 feet of park road on Water Works property which lies in the path of the Corps of Engineers levee. The Corps of Engineers has let the contract for construction, and its contractor built the levee. The Water Works has built the park road.

The City is paying the cost which is \$95,558.30. The City will receive credit to our mandatory portion of the levee for the \$95,558.30.
