**SYNOPSIS —**

The following traffic regulation changes have been reviewed by staff and are recommended for approval:

A. Requests for corner clearances:

1. East side of Southeast Twelfth Street south of East Watrous Avenue;
2. East side of Fortieth Street north of University Avenue; and
3. South side of High Street west of Nineteenth Street.

B. Iowa Cub officials' request for change in parking restrictions adjacent to Sec Taylor Stadium.

**RECOMMENDATION —**

Refer to the Legal Department for preparation of ordinance revisions.

**BACKGROUND —**

- A.1. The Department of Traffic and Transportation has received a request for a corner clearance at Southeast Twelfth Street and East Watrous Avenue. The restriction will improve the vision clearance and reduce the accident potential. The following modification will place the change into effect:

**SEC. 27-1708. SOUTHEAST TWELFTH STREET—RACCOON STREET TO EAST PHILIP STREET.**

Southeast Twelfth Street, on the east side, from East Watrous Avenue to a point 50 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

- A.2. The Waveland Park Neighborhood Association has requested a corner clearance at the intersection of Fortieth Street and University Avenue. The following modification to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect:

**SEC. 27-1885. FORTIETH STREET—GRAND AVENUE TO CRESTMORE CRESTMOOR DRIVE.**

Fortieth Street, on the east side, from University Avenue to a point 75 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Fortieth Street, on the west side, from Douglas Avenue to ~~Crestmore~~ Crestmoor Drive, no parking any time.

- A.3. Peter Nielsen has requested that the corner clearance signs be extended in front of Nielsen Greenhouse & Flower Shop. The request is warranted based on parked cars blocking their driveway. The following modification to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect:

**SEC. 27-2287. HIGH STREET—NINETEENTH STREET TO MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PARKWAY.**

High Street, on the south side, from Nineteenth Street to a point ~~50~~ 225 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

- B. Iowa Cub officials have requested a change in the parking restrictions adjacent to the ball park to accommodate additional parking for fans who attend the games. The following amendment to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect:

**SEC. 27-1562. SOUTHWEST FIRST STREET—VINE STREET TO DAVIS STREET.**

Southwest First Street, on the west side, from Market Street to a point ~~400~~ 225 feet south of Elm Street, no parking any time, 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

Southwest First Street, on the west side, from a point 225 feet south of Elm Street to Riverside Drive, no parking any time.
