SYNOPSIS —

The Joint Funding Agreement between the Geological Survey, United States Department of the Interior, and the City of Des Moines, providing for the river- and stream-gaging stations, has been revised so the Geological Survey is now providing funds in an amount that matches the funding provided by the Cities.

FISCAL IMPACT — NO CHANGE TO CITY'S SHARE OF COSTS

The total cost for this period of operation is now \$63,060 (up from \$42,030). The amounts paid by the Cities (Des Moines - \$19,893; West Des Moines & Water Works - \$11,637) have not changed. The amount to be paid by the U.S. Geological Survey has increased from \$10,500 to \$31,530. The funds for this are found in Account No. 330845, *Des Moines and Raccoon River Levee Maintenance*, CIP Page 84.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval of Joint Funding Agreement.

BACKGROUND —

The (revised) Joint Funding Agreement provides money for removal of mercury manometers and replacement with non-mercury manometers. This will result in savings to the Cities in the next year.
