JOINT FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH U.S. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR	◆ RESOLUTION ORDINANCE RECEIVE/FILE	HAROLD E. SMITH CITY ENGINEER

SYNOPSIS —

The Joint Funding Agreement for 1996-1997 between the Geological Survey, United States Department of the Interior, and the City of Des Moines, providing for the river- and stream-gaging stations, has been revised so the Geological Survey is now providing funds in an amount that matches the funding provided by the Cities and paid in the Fall of 1997.

FISCAL IMPACT —

The total cost for this period of operation is now \$54,060 (down from \$63,060). The amounts paid by the Cities are: Des Moines \$18,019.99 (down from \$19,893); West Des Moines \$5,255.84 (down from \$7,508.33); and Water Works \$3,759.17 (down from \$4,128.33). The amount to be paid by the U.S. Geological Survey is \$27,030. Funds for this are found in Account No. 330845, *Des Moines and Raccoon River Levee Maintenance*, CIP page 84.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval of the Joint Funding Agreement.

BACKGROUND —

The (revised) Joint Funding Agreement is provided for in a 28E Agreement (Roll Call No. 96-2001, dated May 28, 1996) between the City of Des Moines, the City of West Des Moines, and the Des Moines Water Works.
