SYNOPSIS —

At the August 13, 1996, meeting, the Park and Recreation Board unanimously approved, by Resolution No. 11743, to approve the 1996-97 28E Agreement with the Des Moines Public Schools for joint use of school and park facilities. The agreement has not changed from last year's agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT —

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval of the 28E Agreement.

BACKGROUND —

The City of Des Moines annually revises the 28E Agreement with the Des Moines Public Schools. The agreement allows the City to utilize school gymnasiums for adult leisure sports during evening hours, while allowing for the School District to utilize parks and golf courses to provide athletic programs for students. The agreement also allows the City to offer open recreation at the Harding Middle School gymnasium on Sunday afternoons during the winter months. The current agreement expired June 30, 1996. The Des Moines School Board approved a renewal of this agreement on August 6, 1996.
