SYNOPSIS —

The renewal of this 28E Agreement with Dowling High School allows for the Des Moines Park and Recreation Department to use Dowling's facilities to offer a Special Olympic Track and Field training program for people with disabilities. The student body has volunteered time as coaches since the inception of this agreement.

BACKGROUND —

The Park and Recreation Department has signed a hold harmless lease agreement with Dowling High School for the use of their facilities for Special Olympic Track and Field practices for the past several years. This will be the tenth year for this type of arrangement. In addition to their sharing facilities, Dowling students have volunteered hundreds of hours coaching Special Olympic Athletics.
