SYNOPSIS -

The following traffic regulation changes have been reviewed by staff and are recommended for approval:

- A. Request for Loading Zone—North side of Crocker Street east of Ninth Street.
- B. Request for Corner Clearance—south side of Woodland Avenue east of Forty-second Street.

BACKGROUND -

A. The Traffic and Transportation Department has received a request from Burns United Methodist Church, 811 Crocker Street, for a loading zone on the north side of Crocker Street in front of the church in order to assist in the access of elderly and handicapped parishioners. The following modification to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect:

SEC. 27-2097. CROCKER STREET—SIXTH AVENUE TO FOURTEENTH STREET.

Crocker Street, on the north side, from a point 50 feet east of Ninth Street to a point 137 feet east thereof, loading zone Saturday and Sunday only.

B. The Traffic and Transportation Department has received a request for a corner clearance on the south side of Woodland Avenue east of Forty-second Street. The following modification to the Municipal Code will place this change into effect:

SEC, 27-2758. WOODLAND AVENUE-THIRTY-FIFTH STREET TO FORTY-SECOND STREET.

Woodland Avenue, on the south side, from Forty-second Street to a point 50 feet east thereof, no parking any time.
