**BACKGROUND —**

On March 27, 1995, by Roll Call No. 95-1178, the City Council established the composition of the Enterprise Community Steering Committee, which includes 25 members from the community and agencies that serve the community.

On October 21, 1996, by Roll Call No. 96-3548, the City Council accepted the resignation of Reva Henry, the representative from the New Vision Neighborhood Association, from the Enterprise Community Steering Committee.

On October 21, 1996, by Roll Call No. 96-3548, the City Council accepted the resignation of Doris Dabo, the at-large neighborhood representative, from the Enterprise Community Steering Committee. Ms. Dabo was asked to resign because of her failure to fulfill the attendance requirement.

The Enterprise Community Steering Committee Chair has received communication from New Vision identifying Janice Cochran as the new representative to the Enterprise Community Steering Committee with Celeste Morris as her alternate.

The Enterprise Community Steering Committee has received communication from the five Enterprise Community Neighborhood Associations (EC5) identifying Reva Henry as the new at-large neighborhood representative to the Enterprise Community Steering Committee with Carole Daye as her alternate.
