SYNOPSIS —

To accommodate the construction of a new service road south of the existing employee parking lot, an existing transformer must be relocated.

FISCAL IMPACT —

A one-time fee of \$3,581.84. Funds are available in the adopted 1997-98 Capital Improvements Program (CIP), page 36, Economy Parking Lot Expansion, Phase 2.

RECOMMENDATION —

Approval of Agreement.

BACKGROUND —

On January 7, 1997, City Council gave authorization to proceed with the Airport Overflow Parking Lot Project. An agreement with MidAmerican Energy Company to relocate an existing transformer is necessary for the construction of a new service road.
