SYNOPSIS –

Requesting City Manager to proceed with Southeast Airport Trunk Sanitary Sewer project.

FISCAL IMPACT –

Funding for this project is provided for in account number 377960 of the 1997-98 Capital Improvements Program entitled the Southeast Airport Trunk Sanitary Sewer.

RECOMMENDATION –

That all objections to the proposed ordinance, which have been fully reviewed and considered, be overruled and the hearing on said matter be concluded and closed.

BACKGROUND –

On May 19, 1997 by Roll Call No. 97-1731, the City Council authorized the City Manager to proceed with the Southeast Airport Trunk Sanitary Sewer project. On November 17, 1997, by Roll Call No. 97-3722, the City Council set a time and place for a hearing on a proposed connection fee ordinance establishing a benefited district to be known as the Southeast Airport Trunk Sanitary Sewer System Benefited District.
