BACKGROUND —

The East 14th Street and East Euclid Avenue Storm Sewer and Detention Basin project will implement one of the recommendations of the July, 1984, Dean's Lake - East 20th Street Drainage Study. Other related projects recommended in the study and previously completed include the Guthrie, Mattern, and Washington detention basins. Construction of the detention basin at East 14th Street and East Euclid Avenue will provide for storm water management in the upper Dean's Lake Watershed, flood mitigation, and redevelopment of the area.

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
