Authorize the City Manager to sign Change Order No. 8 to the Agreement for Engineering Services on the Laboratory and Personnel Facilities Expansion, Work Order No. 210-97-002.

BACKGROUND -

On July 21, 1997, by Roll Call No. 97-2483, the City Council authorized and directed the Mayor to execute a contract with The Weitz Company, Inc. for construction of the Des Moines Metropolitan Wastewater Reclamation Authority Laboratory and Personnel Facilities Expansion at the Wastewater Reclamation Facility. During excavation for the building 92 north addition, it was discovered that an electrical ductbank is located within the foundation of the north addition. The electrical ductbank will need to be relocated out of the north addition foundation. Change Order No. 8 also provides a credit for elimination of storm sewer removal. The storm sewer is to be filled with K-crete instead of total removal.

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
