City Council approval is requested for a consultant contract with Shive-Hattery, Inc., Tom Hayden, President, 1601 48th Street, Suite 200, West Des Moines, IA, 50266-6748, for Design and Construction Phase Services, in the amount of \$49,350.00, for the Equipment Maintenance Center (EMC) Renovation and Car Wash project.

FISCAL IMPACT -

Funding for this project is included in the adopted 1998/1999 Capital Improvements Program. Originally the project was in two parts - EMC Renovation (page 168, 1998/99 CIP) and EMC Service Station (page 169, 1998/99 CIP). For efficiency these two projects have been combined into one. Total funds allocated for this project are \$423,000.

RECOMMENDATION –

Approval of consultant contract. Shive-Hattery, Inc. has been the consultant on previous work at the EMC and has become familiar with the building and its systems. Their knowledge of the existing building systems will impact the quality of the final product.
