**Approval of Change Order No. 1 with Des Moines Asphalt & Paving Company.**

**BACKGROUND –**

On May 18, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-1638, the City Council approved Contract No. 13080, 1998 Asphaltic Cement Concrete (ACC) Pavement Milling and Resurfacing, which has a provision for increasing bid items by up to 20 percent without affecting the unit bid prices. In order to ensure timely completion of the Public Works Department’ s ACC Overlay Program, we are recommending this provision be used.
