Authorize the City Manager to proceed with the project as outlined herein.

BACKGROUND –

1. Stormwater Utility Emergency Repairs, Page 304, in the Adopted CIP– \$50,000 estimated project cost. The construction of a berm to divert stormwater away from a private business and toward an existing storm sewer system. This project will improve the local drainage in the area.

2. Stormwater Utility Emergency Repairs, Page 304, in the Adopted CIP– \$60,000 estimated project cost. A tributary of Four Mile Creek frequently overtops its banks which causes flooding to homes on East 42nd Street and Williams Street. This project involves the construction of a berm to divert the water away from these properties and toward Four Mile Creek.

3. Citywide Stormwater Utility Projects, Page 292, in the

Adopted CIP– \$75,000 estimated project cost. The construction of a small detention basin and associated storm sewer to improve the storm sewer system which has been the source of numerous complaints. This project is in conjunction with the three-party contract storm sewer being built across the street at 3700 East University.
