	BACKGROUND –
	During the past year, the Traffic and Transportation Division
	has consulted with Senior Police Officer Steve Silver, Uniform
	Services Division; Special Operations-Traffic Unit with Des
	Moines Police Department; and Mike Jenkins, General
	Manager of Yellow/Capitol Cab Company to update the taxical
	ordinance.
	The proposed ordinance changes are the result of consultations
	between the taxi companies, the Des Moines Police
	Department, and the Engineering Department's Traffic and
	Transportation Division.
	The proposed changes fall within three general areas:

1. Stricter dress, appearance, and conduct standards for cab drivers, as requested by the taxicab company.

2. Redefining application requirements and procedures. Requires the first-time taxicab driver's license applicant to request an FBI criminal records check and submit to fingerprinting, at their expense, as a part of the initial application process. The requirements for renewal of a taxicab driver's license are reduced to a short-form application. Police records considered during the application process will now cover a five-year period for driving records, rather than three years, and criminal history for a ten-year period, rather than five years. New applicants from out-of-state will now be required to furnish a certified copy of their driving records for the preceding five years.

3. Updates the taxicab ordinance to acknowledge the elimination of the Traffic and Transportation Department and the creation of the Traffic and Transportation Division, within the Engineering Department.

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
