BACKGROUND —

The 28E Agreement allows both agencies use of each other's facilities for programs and services. This agreement has been revised and renewed annually for over ten years. The general provisions for use shall remain the same and include:

City:

- 1) Use of Brody, Callahan, Goodrell, Harding, Hiatt, Meredith, Merrill, and Weeks Middle School gymnasium and locker rooms and Hoover High School swimming pool and locker rooms to conduct indoor neighborhood recreational activities from October 1, 1997 to March 28, 1998.
- 2) Use of McCombs Middle School grounds for U-Control model airplane flying.

School District:

1) Use of Nahas Aquatic Center parking lot from

September 2, 1997 to June 2, 1998.

- 2) Use of the facilities of the Blank Park Zoo for a Veterinary Technician class.
- 3) Use of Ewing Park to conduct cross country races upon written notification from the School District.
- 4) Use of Park and Recreation administrative offices and parking lot (formerly known as the Leisure Sports and Park Planners Office) for Community and Adult Education administrative purposes, with the exception of telephone service payments.
