The joint Funding Agreement for 1998/99 between the U.S. Geological Survey, U.S. Department of the Interior, and the City of Des Moines, providing for the river- and stream-gaging stations, has been revised so the Geological Survey is now providing funds in an amount that matches the funding provided by the cities and paid in the Fall of 1999.

FISCAL IMPACT —

The total cost for this period is \$60,600. The amounts paid by the cities are: Des Moines, \$24,381.34; West Des Moines, \$9,285.33; and Des Moines Water Works, \$6,733.33. The amount to be paid by the U.S. Geological Survey is \$22,200. Funds for this are found in Capital Improvement Program Index Code No. 330845, Des Moines, and Raccoon River Levee Maintenance.
