Mrs. Sanders entered into a Mortgage Agreement that was assigned to the Iowa Finance Authority (IFA). She has defaulted on the mortgage and the property is currently vacant and abandoned.

The Department of Housing and Urban Development has authorized the City to convey its interest in the property to IFA in order to enable them to market the house for single-family occupancy.

Approval of the Quit Claim Deed and assigning all interest in the real estate contract to IFA will allow them to return the property to the City's usable housing stock.
