SYNOPSIS -

Michele Bischof, (0-NR), Loss Control Specialist, Human Resources, to Dallas, Texas, from December 13, 1998 to December 20, 1998, to attend a workshop sponsored by Development Dimensions International. She will obtain Implementation Planning and Facilitation skills training in order to provide quality training to City employees.

FISCAL IMPACT -

The total expended on City travel from July 1, 1998 through December 7, 1998, is \$130,318.23; the total amount budgeted for City travel is approximately \$370,000.
