The base bid amount is \$1,250 per month for an annual cost of \$15,000 which is an increase of \$3,000 per year over last year. The additional cost for FY98-99 of \$1,750 will be absorbed in the currently approved budget.

The duration of the contract is for one year and renewable for two additional years. The sole bidder is Dr. Dennis Riordan, who has been the Zoo's consulting veterinarian since 1987. The Purchasing Department sent letters to 13 local veterinarians inquiring why they did not respond to the bid. Their response was that they did not have the clinical experience for the specialized veterinary care required for exotic and native animals.

It requires many years of experience to maintain an effective exotic animal veterinary practice. Zoos customarily employ a staff veterinarian. However, the size of the Blank Park Zoo's animal collection does not warrant a full-time staff position which would cost in excess of \$100,000 per year.

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
