LIQUID ASPHALT
MATERIALS

On February 16, 1999, the City received a single bid for liquid asphalt materials in accordance with Specification No. 98-99-36. The bid from Bituminous Materials and Supply Company (900 East Raccoon Street, Des Moines, Iowa, Michael J. Kelly, President), which did not increase from the last two years' prices, was compared with bids obtained by the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) and was determined to be competitive.

Funding is currently available in the Public Works Department's Operating Budget for the purchase of \$190,000 worth of required liquid asphalt materials.

Approval of the sole bid received from Bituminous Materials and Supply Company for emulsified asphalt materials.

BACKGROUND -

The Public Works Department uses liquid asphalt materials in a variety of preventive maintenance and repair programs including chip and slurry seal, asphalt stabilization, and crack sealing. In addition, the materials are used to control dust on unpaved streets and to prepare paved streets for asphalt overlay.

Specifications for liquid asphalt materials were sent to two companies, with one bid received, which has been the case during the last four years. The next closest supplier of liquid asphalt materials is located in Omaha, Nebraska. This company

has bid in the past but has never been competitive with the local company because of delivery costs. They stopped bidding in 1993.

The single bid, which did not increase from the last two years' prices, was compared with the bids received for similar materials by IDOT. It was found that the City's prices were comparable to those obtained by the State of Iowa.
