Item #74-G on tonight's agenda is a bid award for 13 utility vehicles for the Police Department-six to be used for the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Program and seven to be used in the School Resource Officer Program.

This item is related to, but different from, another item on the March 1 Council agenda. There were two relevant vehicle-purchase agenda items on March 1: Agenda item #41-F was for four NEW utility vehicles to be used by the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Team members in the Community Development Department; and Agenda item #41-I was for 25 REPLACEMENT vehicles (of which a handful were "utility vehicles") for the Police Department. Item #74-G tonight is for 13 vehicles, which are new to the Police Department, because the Department's participation in both the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Program and the School Resource Officer Program is new.

FISCAL IMPACT -

Funding in the amount of \$137,831.10 is currently available from the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Program; \$160,802.95 is currently available from the School Resource Officer Program, for a total amount of \$298,634.05.

RECOMMENDATION -

Approve the low compliant bid from Mid-States Ford Sterling for 13 utility vehicles to be used by the Police Department-six for the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Program and seven for the School Resource Officer Program.

BACKGROUND -

The recommended bid award is consistent with previous actions to establish and fund both the Neighborhood-Based Service Delivery Program and the School Resource Officer Program.
