BACKGROUND -

On February 16, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-403, the City Council authorized the City Manager to proceed with the Frisbie Park Sanitary Pump Station and Jackson Street Sanitary Pump Station projects. Subsequent to Council authorization to proceed, the Engineering Department identified Veenstra and Kimm, Inc. as the most qualified firm to provide the planning and design services for this project. The project has been bid and is being awarded by separate Council action. Veenstra and Kimm, Inc. will perform the construction services work including general services, resident review services, and construction staking services. This work will be administered out of their West Des Moines office, which is located at 3000 Westown Parkway, West Des Moines, Iowa 50266. This agreement shall be completed within 180 days after award of

the contract.

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
