At its meeting of November 16, 1999, the Polk County Board of Supervisors approved the renewal of four (4) lease agreements with the City for space at four community centers: Archie Brooks, Logan, Four Mile, and Southeast Community Centers.

The Space Allocation Agreements, which are on file in the City Clerk's office, are assessed at a rate of \$1.25 per square foot. The Polk County Elderly Service Division uses the City's Community Centers to provide meals to seniors.
