CITY COUNCIL ITEM **COMMUNICATION:** OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER CITY OF DES MOINES, IOWA 00-003 **SYNOPSIS** -**AGENDA:** On January 3, 1995, by Roll Call No. 95-70, Council approved a Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) Agreement 95-R-001 with the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) for JANUARY 3, 2000 the design and construction of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway from SW 2nd Street to Fleur Drive. This RISE Agreement was **SUBJECT:** for a grant of \$25,203,860 plus a RISE loan of \$4,447,740. REVITALIZE IOWA'S A November 29, 1999, letter agreement with IDOT changes the SOUND ECONOMY \$4,447,740 loan from a general obligation on the part of the City to a loan guaranteed solely by the City's future road use (RISE) AGREEMENT tax fund allocations. The agreement calls for repayment of the 95-R-001 BETWEEN THE CITY AND loan at zero percent per annum interest and shall be repaid in **IOWA** eight annual installments of \$555,968. The first payment shall DEPARTMENT OF be due one year from the date the RISE project is completed TRANSPORTATION and opened to traffic. If, because of project underruns or other reasons, the total RISE funds loaned to the City is less than the MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PARKWAY maximum stated above, the annual payment shall be reduced accordingly. The action of the letter of understanding with IDOT does not change the amount of the grant or the loan. On January 3, 1995, by Roll Call No. 95-70, Council approved

a RISE Agreement with IDOT for the design and construction of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway from SW 2nd Street to Fleur Drive. On June 23, 1997, by Roll Call No. 97-2236, Council approved a revised preliminary design on the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway project. The City is currently proceeding with right-of-way acquisition, design, and construction of various segments of this project.
