On December 20, 1999, by Roll Call 99-3864, Council gave preliminary approval for a \$70,000 economic development loan to Architects Smith Metzger. The company is purchasing and renovating 2111 Grand Avenue. Robert Smith is a Des Moines resident and Daryl Metzger lives in Johnston. Michael Ryan is the Office of Economic Development contact with the company. Loan documents have been prepared for Council approval.

BACKGROUND -

Architects Smith Metzger was formed in 1998. Prior to that, Daryl Metzger and Robert Smith had both been partners and principals in other local architectural firms. The firm has a variety of institutional, commercial, and residential clients. The proposed project will provide a larger facility for the company and enhance the company's professional image and increase its ability to retain and attract staff. The Grand Avenue facility will also provide on site parking.

First Bank will loan \$500,000 and the principals will provide \$25,000. The \$70,000 City loan will more nearly equalize the cost of the Des Moines location when to compared to suburban locations.
