BACKGROUND -

RUSSELL **UNDERWOOD ACTING ASSISTANT** CITY MANAGER On February 1, 1999, Council approved an application to FEMA for a Project Impact Hazard Mitigation Grant. Subsequently, FEMA approved the application making Des Moines a Project Impact Community. As a Project Impact community, Des Moines was awarded a \$300,000 grant for hazard mitigation. The grant designates \$200,000 to buy structures located in the floodplain, \$50,000 for 1,000 weather radios to be distributed throughout the City, and \$50,000 for the further development of the GIS. The GIS can be used to identify future mitigation efforts and flood prone areas in the City.
