BACKGROUND -

DMDC Property Corp. acquired this site in 1995, in anticipation of the proposed Grocery Store project for \$22,500. They have incurred additional costs for property management and demolition of an abandoned building on the site for \$14,243. DMDC Property Corp. has requested the City take ownership of the property at a price that covers their investment in the property.

The fair market value of the vacant property is estimated by the City's Right-of-Way Appraiser to be \$13,000. However, the proposed purchase price is likely less than the costs the City would have incurred had the City been responsible for securing and demolishing the structure and related costs.



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
