The Council appointed the membership of the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) Advisory Board, accepted the LLEBG Advisory Board charge, and approved the proposed LLEBG Advisory Board schedule of events at the January 24, 2000 Council meeting. The LLEBG Advisory Board held their first meeting on February 9, 2000 to review the grant application. The LLEBG Advisory Board's second meeting and public hearing was held March 10, 2000, at 10:00 AM, at Police Headquarters. The LLEBG Advisory Board has prepared and is forwarding their report of non-binding recommendations on the Police Department's proposed use of grant funds.

The total award is in the amount of \$306,567, which includes the LLEBG award of \$275,910 and the use of \$30,657 in forfeited funds for local match. The grant application purpose area the Police Department applied for was "Law enforcement support for procuring equipment, technology and other material directly related to basic law enforcement functions." Acquisition of equipment will follow accepted City purchasing procedures.

The Council approved the grant application and authorized the

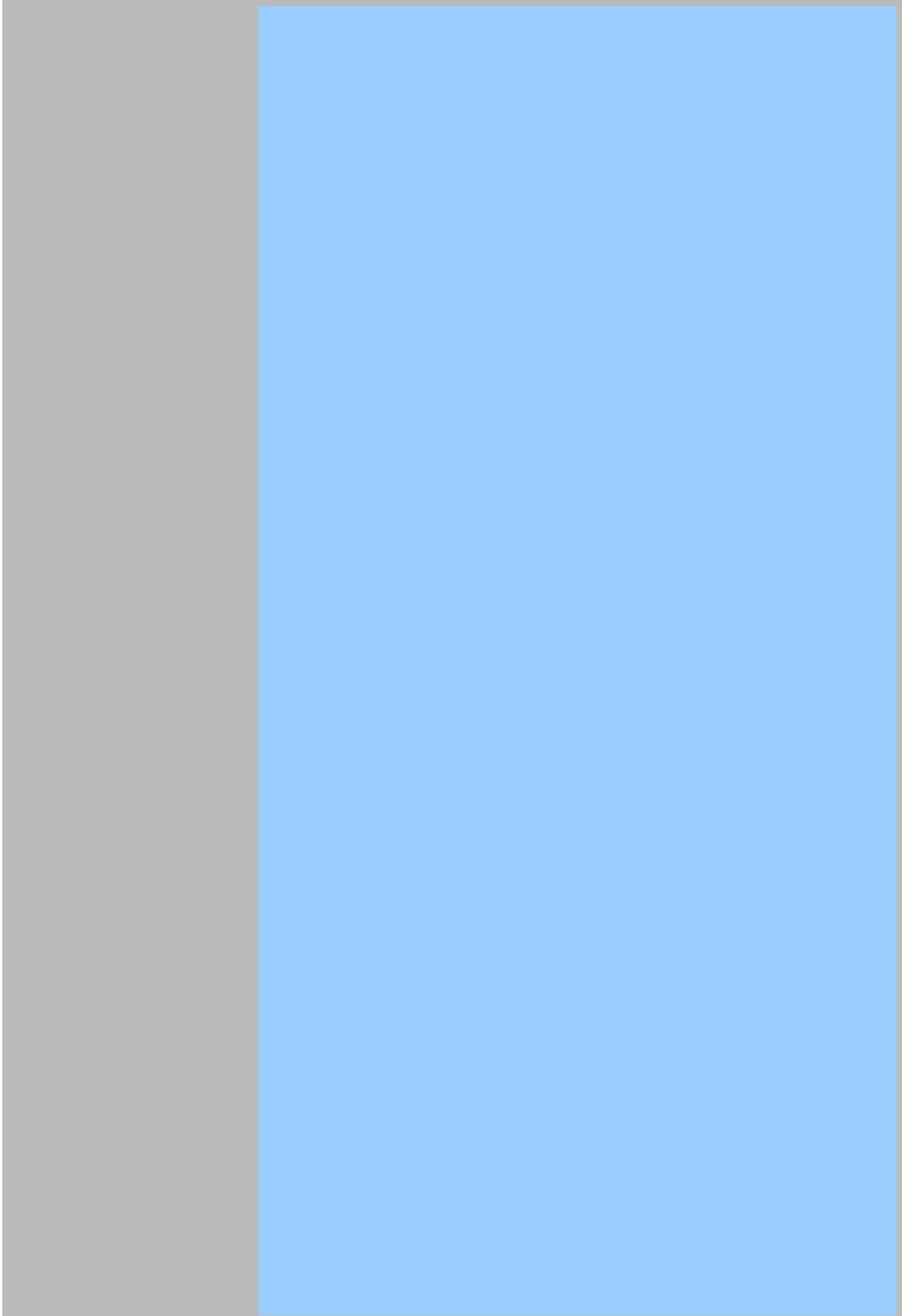

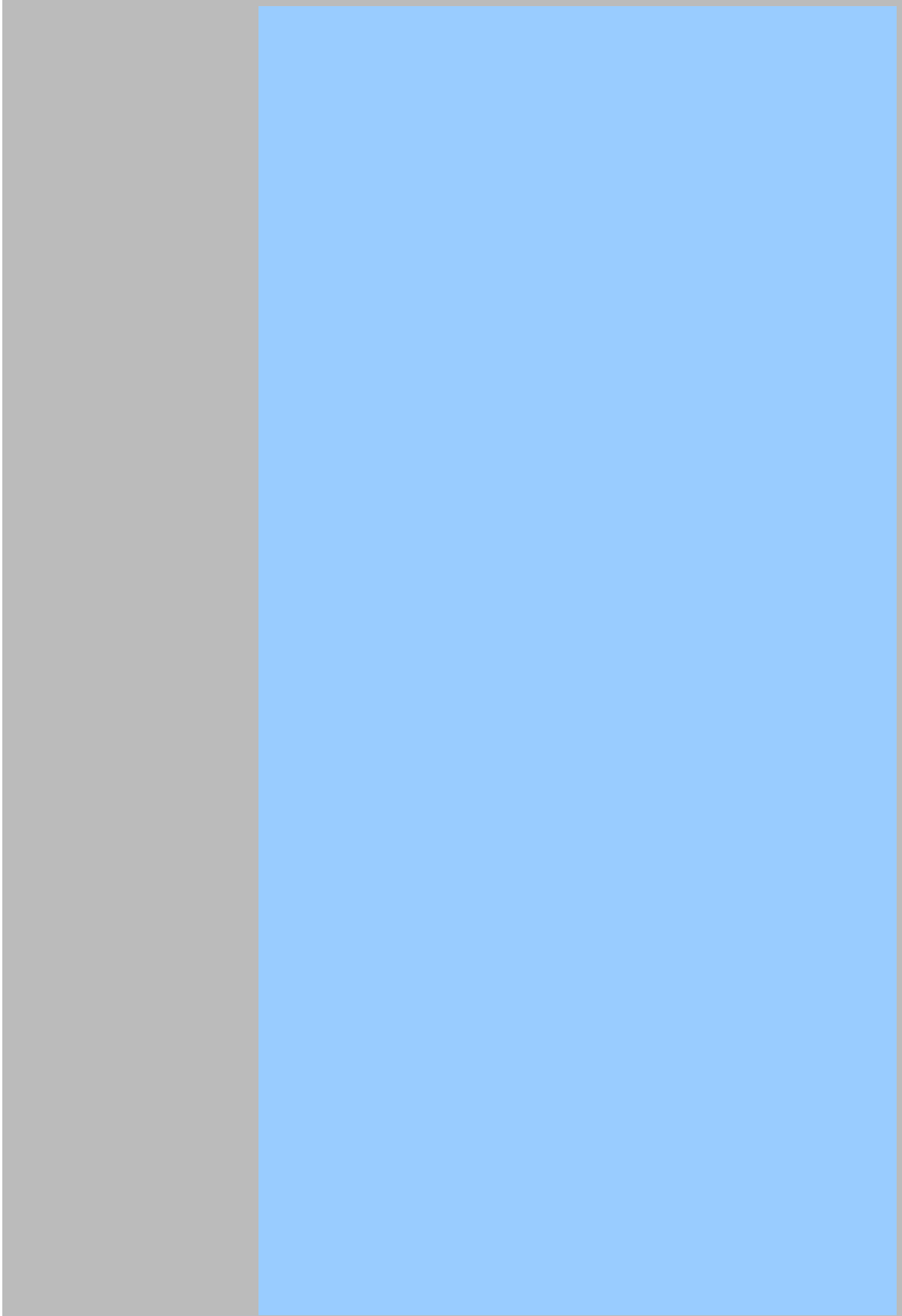
