SYNOPSIS -

The Police Department has prepared a grant application to the Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse (GASA) requesting continuation funding for the "Youth at Risk" program. If approved, the application will be submitted to GASA requesting Federal "Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance" funding for the program. The required 25 percent grant match funding is available from the Police Department's Operating Budget, with program funding to begin July 1, 2000 and running through June 30, 2001.

FISCAL IMPACT -

The total budget request for this program is \$150,384.20 with federal funding of \$112,788.15 and a required 25 percent City match funding of \$37,596.05. The Police Department's Operating Budget will provide the City match funding.

BACKGROUND -

The City Council approved the original "Youth at Risk" proposal and accepted the award from the Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse on March 22, 1999, by Roll Call No. 99-835.

The "Youth at Risk" program concept was developed to create a partnership between the Des Moines Police Department, Juvenile Court, and the State's Youthful Offender program in

order to take enforcement actions against adjudicated youth who taunt the criminal justice system through continued disobedience to court ordered sanctions.
