WILLIAM MOULDER CHIEF OF POLICE Rock In Prevention is requesting the City to sponsor a \$70,000 pass-through grant from the Governor's Alliance on Substance Abuse. This grant will enable Rock In Prevention to continue a drug prevention program that is currently operating in 15 Des Moines Schools.

The program trains high school students to work with elementary age children on drug prevention strategies. The money comes from the BYRNE program through the Department of Justice. The grant is named after a New York City policeman who was killed in a shoot-out.

The program year is July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001, and requires that the City be the sponsor.
