BACKGROUND -

CHIEF OF POLICE

The City Council has approved, in concept, the construction of a boat ramp and the remodeling of the Crime Prevention Building during the CIP hearings in February 2000. The boat ramp is to be constructed at a site safely away from the river dams. Rescue operations for police and fire teams will be greatly enhanced as well as engineering inspections of river bridges. The Public Works Director has determined his department can completely construct this ramp for the budgeted amount.

The Crime Prevention Building requires a number of basic repairs and renovations. This includes foundation repairs, rest rooms, windows, wall painting, and door replacements. The section staff would also like to construct a food preparation area for public meetings.
