This has involved research on Public Arts Programs in other DEVELOPMENT cities, and interviews with individuals associated with the programs. DIRECTOR The Task Force also worked with Design Iowa, an initiative of the Iowa Arts Council, and their advisors, Bruce Williams, Coordinator of Artists and Public Art Programs for the Iowa Arts Council, and Jack Becker, Project Manager for Forecast Public Artworks in St. Paul, Minnesota.
