On May 3, 1999, by Roll Call No. 99-1410, the City Council approved issuing a Request For Proposal (RFP) to hire a consultant to study and analyze the existing opportunities and constraints of the City's wading pools. On September 13, 1999, by Roll Call No. 99-2843, the City entered into an agreement with The Larkin Group, Inc. to provide conceptual designs for new water playgrounds to replace the existing wading pools.

The City recommends hiring The Larkin Group, Inc. to complete the design for the water playground to be installed at Martin Luther King, Jr. Park. The Larkin Group's preliminary work on the conceptual plans will allow them the ability to move this project ahead in a timely fashion. The \$100,000 gift from American Republic to complete the water playground project necessitates expediting the construction of the improvements to the park.

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
