BACKGROUND -

As a result of the citywide stormwater needs analysis, one of the high priority projects identified is a storm sewer project in the eastern portion of the Arlington Watershed. This project will help to remove stormwater from the combined sewers in the area and is included in the 2000-2001 CIP utilizing Stormwater Utility funds. It is anticipated the project will be constructed in the right-of-way of College Avenue, and any additional right-of-way or easement needs will be limited to property adjacent to College Avenue.
