Emergency attempts to correct the problem using city contractors were unsuccessful. Inspection revealed serious plumbing flaws located below a severely deteriorated portion of the structure. Correction will require significant removal and rebuilding of building structural systems. |

Ms. Carol Johnson's Attorney, Mr. Brett I. Anderson, has notified the city that the property has been vacated, but Ms. Johnson will not have the property under control prior to council hearing. No commitment was made regarding correction or demolition of the property.

No response was received from the remaining parties with interest in the property.

The city has caused this structure to be vacated, boarded and secured.

This action will enable the city to bring legal action to cause its demolition or repair in the event the titleholders fail to bring the building into compliance.
