The City of Des Moines is currently participating in a contract with the Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau, which provides funds to support traffic enforcement operations by purchasing equipment to enhance Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) enforcement efforts. The City Council approved the current year equipment contract on September 27, 1999, with Roll Call No. 99-2965. This contract expires September 30, 2000.
