FISCAL IMPACT -

The City of Des Moines' portion of this joint utility duct is \$15,587.94, which is included in the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget for MLK - East/West segment. Revenue of \$82,107.74 from the utilities will be deposited in the MLK CIP budget.

RECOMMENDATION -

BACKGROUND -

The City of Des Moines Engineering Department and its consultant, Earth Tech, have been involved in planning, discussions, and negotiations with a number of private utilities and telecommunication providers to accommodate the needs of all such users utilizing a shared utility duct bank which is to be

constructed by the City in conjunction with the MLK project, thus avoiding construction conflicts and delays in the construction of MLK and the various utility facilities.

The participating entities are City/Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) utility ducts for traffic signalization interconnect, Qwest, MidAmerican Energy Company, McLeod, and AT&T Cable. These entities have negotiated this agreement to provide for sharing of construction costs of the shared utility duct bank and to provide for the ongoing use, operation, and maintenance of the shared utility duct bank. The cost sharing is to be pro-rated to each respective entity based on the number and length of duct to be utilized by each entity and the unit bid price for this work under the contract with M. Peterson Construction Company for paving MLK. The prorated cost for each entity is shown below.
