FISCAL IMPACT -

The total expended on City travel from July 1, 2000 through August 2, 2000 is \$51,928.83; the total amount budgeted for City travel is approximately \$346,000.

BACKGROUND -

On January 20, 1992, by Roll Call No. 92-214, the City Council approved a revision to the policy for travel authorization requests.

Such revision requires trips that exceed three days and \$1,250 cost to be approved by the Council. The number in parentheses indicates the total number of trips previously authorized for that individual for the current budget year; R represents resident and NR represents non-resident.

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
