Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to the Engineering Services Agreement with the professional engineering firm of Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. (H.R. Veenstra, Jr., President, 3000 Westown Parkway, Westown Parkway, West Des Moines, IA 50266-1320) would provide additional out-of-scope professional engineering design services for the proposed Wastewater Reclamation Authority (WRA) Southwest Outfall Relief Sewer, Phase 12, Segment 1, Activity ID No. 01-1997-004.

The amount is not to exceed \$40,000. Funding for this project is with WRA Funds, Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Index 39168 - WRA Southwest Outfall Relief Sewer - Phase 12 - Account 543040 - Fund EN267 - Organization ENG990000 - Project/Grant WRA061.

**BACKGROUND -**

On August 5, 1996, by Roll Call No. 96-2710, Council authorized the Mayor to sign an agreement with the engineering firm of Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. to provide professional engineering work necessary to design the sewer facilities described as Phase 12, Segment 1.

On May 5, 1997, by Roll Call No. 97-1585, Council authorized the Mayor to sign a Supplemental No. 1 to this professional services contract to provide for Phase 1 Site Environmental Investigations.

On May 4, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-1370, Council authorized the Mayor to sign a Supplemental No. 2 to this professional services contract to provide for a significant change in redesigning the sewer alignment and for incorporating the new Urban Standard Specifications for Public Improvements into the specifications of the project.

On September 28, 1998, by Roll call No. 98-2951, Council authorized the Mayor to sign a Supplemental No. 3 to this professional services contract to provide for a change in the alignment to locate a sewer along the east side of the Metro Transit Authority (MTA) property, to coordinate with the construction of the storm sewer being constructed as a part of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway project and to provide a corridor along the east side of the MTA property which is constructable and acceptable to MTA.

Supplemental No. 4 will provide for general administrative services and construction staking services during the construction of the Phase 12 Southwest Outfall Relief Sewer.
