The City's storm and sanitary utilities and the WRA have a significant investment in pump stations throughout the City. This request for proposals is an effort to standardize the equipment and service in these and future stations, thereby reducing parts inventory, allow maintenance staff more specialized training, and provide a single point of contact for technical assistance.

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
