Traffic Safety Funding to construct new traffic signals on Douglas

In addition to the new traffic signals, some minor regrading on the northwest corner of the intersection is planned to improve sight

distance. The new signal will be interconnected to the existing signals

on Douglas Avenue at Merle Hay Road and at Beaver Avenue. Also, the existing mid-block school signal in the 5100 block of Douglas Avenue for Moore Elementary School will be relocated farther west to between 51st and 52nd Streets, in front of the school's entrance.

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
