WILLIAM H. Federal legislation has established a Juvenile Accountability MOULDER Incentive Block Grant program. In Iowa, the program is

administered by the State Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning and Statistical Analysis Center. A portion of these funds is available to certain units of local government. The funds are for programs to reduce juvenile delinquency, improve the juvenile justice system, and increase accountability for juvenile offenders.

The City is eligible for a grant of \$73,350.
