The funds will be used for AGREEMENT "bricks and mortar" while the City will continue to fund staff costs and overhead through Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. **TYPE: <u>RESOLUTION</u>** ORDINANCE **RECOMMENDATION -RECEIVE/FILE** Approval. **SUBMITTED BY: BACKGROUND** -JAMES GRANT COMMUNITY In March 2000, West Bank applied for an Affordable Housing DEVELOPMENT Program (AHP) Grant from the Federal Home Loan Bank in the DIRECTOR amount of \$249,999 to be used in conjunction with funds allocated for the Emergency Repair Loan Program. These funds are administered by the Neighborhood Conservation Services Division of the Community Development Department. In July 1999, West Bank was awarded \$249,999 in the form of a grant for this purpose. On September 25, 2000, the City Council approved an agreement between West Bank and the City of Des Moines. Since that time, West Bank has supplied the City with an additional agreement for the

same program and activities to be approved by the City Council. In previous years, these two agreements were approved at the same time.

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
