The Joint Funding Agreement for 2000/2001 between the U.S. Geological Survey, U.S. Department of the Interior, and the City of Des Moines, provides for operating and maintenance of six river and stream gaging stations. This agreement is revised annually to reflect current costs.

FISCAL IMPACT -

The total cost for this period is \$65,400. The amounts paid by the cities are: Des Moines - \$26,341.68, West Des Moines - \$9,991.66; and Des Moines Water Works - \$7,266.66. The amount to be paid by the U.S. Geological Survey is \$21,800. Funds for this agreement are found in Capital Improvements Program Index Code No. 330845, Des Moines and Raccoon River Levee Maintenance, Account 543100, Fund CP033, Organization ENG990000, Project/Grant FLD008.

BACKGROUND -

The Joint Funding Agreement is provided for in a 28E Agreement (Roll Call No. 96-2001, dated May 28, 1996) between the City of Des Moines, the City of West Des Moines, and the Des Moines Water Works.
