JIM GRANT With the involvement of a Citizen's Design Committee, the design **COMMUNITY** firm of RDG Crose Gardner Shukert, Inc., developed a Master **DEVELOPMENT** Aesthetic Plan for the reconstruction of I-235. Neighborhood gateways with public art components at the I-235 interchanges in Des DIRECTOR Moines are a component of the plan. This plan includes safety,

maintenance, security and vandalism considerations for the design of art work.
