RESOLUTION ORDINANCE RECEIVE/FILE **RECOMMENDATION -**Approval. **SUBMITTED BY:** WILLIAM H. **BACKGROUND** -MOULDER CHIEF OF POLICE The Iowa Department of Commerce has received funds from tobacco settlements to conduct checks on tobacco retailers for compliance with prohibitions on the sale of tobacco to minors. The Vice and Narcotics Control Section of the Police Department will perform the work on an overtime basis. The City has approximately 350 cigarette license permit holders. Random and

The City will be reimbursed \$50 for each compliance check. We estimate the cost will be approximately \$35,000.

unannounced compliance checks will be made on these permit

holders.

On July 13, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-2216, the City Council approved a similar program for tobacco retailer compliance. This program continues that concept.
